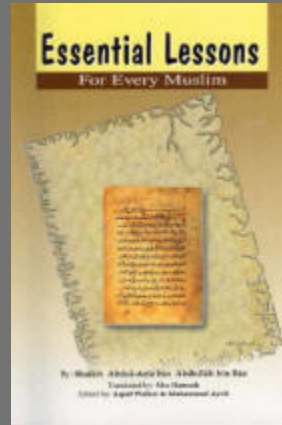
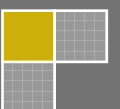

Lesson 1: Memorization of Suwar

I. Reading/Listening:

1. Read Lesson One in the text.
2. II. Apply

1. Make a chart of the suwar that we should memorize at the least. Or use one of the following TJ charts available from TJ's Quraan Home Page:

 - Color in a box for each ayaah memorized
 - [Quraan Progress Chart, by Surah](#) (.DOC)
 - Track your progress through the whole Quraan by surah.
2. Mark which suwar you know on the chart. How many do you need to memorize, if any?
3. Make a memorization schedule to try to memorize any of the suwar that you do not know this year.

Teacher Tip:

You could have student memorize or review one surah per week as they go through the Essential Lessons lessons.
