

Salatul Fajr



- The first prayer that we pray in the day is in the morning and it is called Salatul Fajr.
- Fajr is the time of daybreak, the time when light first appears in the sky at the beginning of a day.
- The light is from the sun which is beginning to rise at that time.
- We must pray salat al fajr before the sun rises.
- The sun rises in the east.
- The word for sun in Arabic is shams.
- It is very hard for many people to get up and make the fajr prayer on time because it is so early. But it is very important for us to be sure to make this prayer.

Angels take turns around you, some at night and some by day, and all of them assemble together at the time of the Fajr and 'Asr prayers.

The angels of the night and the angels of the day meet at Salat Al-Fajr.)

The angels of the night and the day attend this prayer. (Tafsir Ibn Kathir, Tafsir Surah 13 and Tafsir Al Fatihaah)
