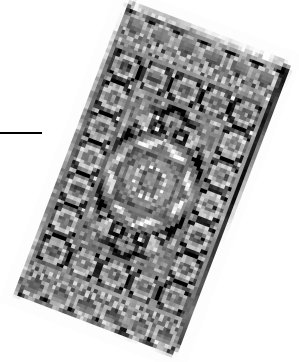


Lesson 16: Tarteel/Correcting the Imam.....



1. Introduction:

It will be said to the reciter of the Quraan (on the Day of Judgment), 'Recite and ascend; recite slowly and rhythmically as you used to do in the previous world; your place will be at the last ayaah you recite. (PPD)

2. Overview:

After this lesson, you should be able to answer the following questions:

- 🕌 What is Tarteel?
- 🕌 What will be said to the reciter of the Quraan on the Day of Judgment?
- 🕌 Give two descriptions of how the Prophet (salla Allahu alayhi wa sallam) used to recite.
- 🕌 Is it permissible to correct the imam when praying? What is a proof?
- 🕌 What should be done when the shaytaan confuses you in prayer? Cite the proof.

4. Terms to Know:

Find and write the following terms/phrases in Arabic in your notebook.

What is "tafl?" Write this word in Arabic.

5. Think about It!

Answer the questions from the Overview section in your notebook.

6. Hifz (Memorize)

Optional: Memorize the hadith quoted in the Introduction, or the proof for seeking refuge with Allah from Shaytan in the prayer. (try to do so in Arabic, if possible).

7. Apply!

Pick a surah. Recite it in a manner based upon what you learned in this reading. Have your teacher listen to you.

Demonstrate/practice the correct way to repel the shaytaan during prayer as learned in the lesson.
