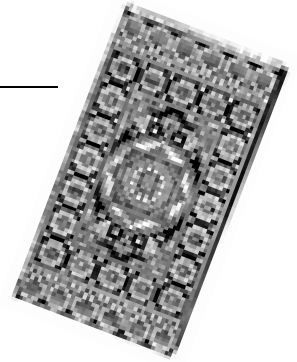


# Lesson 19: Second Rakah; Tashahhud

---



## 1. Introduction:

"...he (sal-Allaahu 'alayhe wa sallam) would sit for tashahhud after finishing the second rak'ah. In a two-rak'ah prayer such as Fajr, "he would sit muftarishan" as he used to sit between the two sajdahs, and "he would sit in the first tashahhud similarly" in a three or four-rak'ah prayer." (PPD)
