

## Lesson 3: Prayer Wearing Shoes



### 1. Introduction:

"He used to stand (in prayer) bare-footed sometimes and wearing shoes sometimes."

When one of you prays, he should wear his shoes or take them off and put them between his feet, and not harm others with them.

Therefore, when one of you goes to the mosque, he should look at his shoes: if he sees in them dirt - or he said: something harmful - he should wipe them and pray in them.

If possible, learn in Arabic.
