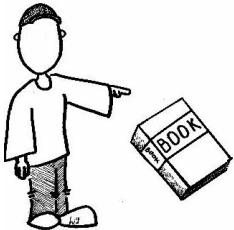
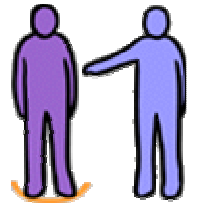
Learn: Pronouns
