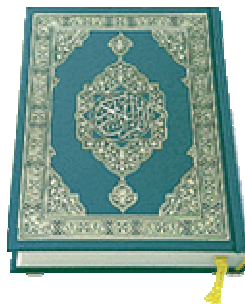

Tip: I write the Arabic on one line and the correlating English on the line just under it, matching it up word for word (as much as possible) or by phrase.

2. Look up any Arabic words that you don't know the meaning of as you follow step 1.
3. See if you notice any grammar rules that you have been studying. Ask yourself why is this construction used, why does this word end in a fatha, etc.

- After you are finished with the first set of ayaat, repeat steps IV. Through VII. for each set of ayaat.
- Go back over your outline and generate more questions based upon your outline. Record these in your study questions section.
